volunteering as 2009 Boy Scout Summer Camp staff and Unit Leaders

Subject: Permissive Temporary Duty and Non-Chargeable Leave

Dear Sir or Madam:

This memorandum provides official certification of requests by military personnel for permissive temporary duty and DoD civilians for non-chargeable leave to support Boy Scout summer camps in Korea this summer.

There are not sufficient non-DoD civilian volunteers to fill staff positions at these camps; DoD personnel participation is essential to delivering effective programs for hundreds of Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts from units across Korea. Furthermore, DoD personnel in Scout unit leadership positions will need to accompany their Scout contingents to the summer camp.

Korea District of the Far East Council, Boy Scouts of America, will conduct two summer camps in June at the training area at US Army Garrison Humphreys. Cub Scout Resident Camp will occur 17-20 June, with staff preparation on 16 June. Boy Scout Summer Camp (Camp Liberty) takes place 22-27 June, with staff preparation on 21 June.

Request you approve requests for permissive TDY and non-chargeable leave status from military Scouting volunteers in your organization – both active duty and civilian employees – according to applicable Service regulations.
