**District Committee Meeting date change:** The District meeting in Yongsan, scheduled for 8 March will be held 15 March due to exercises going on at that time.

**Presidents Day Bowl-a-thon:** Keep in mind that the money must be turned into District by 31 Mar for maximum commission. The expected payouts are 25% if turned in by 31 Mar or 15% if turned in by 15 Apr. An extra 10% may be earned if your unit averages \$100 per boy **or** >\$1,000 in pledges.
