Transportation Request: Any unit requesting a bus for transportation between July 08 thru Jun 09 must make the request to Pete at district office by **31 March 08**. This could be for scheduled outings or camp. They physical date is not concrete but the months are (for example you ask for bus on 15 April 09 with pick-up on 22 April 09 for Summer Camp but later it is scheduled for 11 - 18 April. No problem so long as the event falls in the same month.) This can help with transportation problems to Camporees and summer camps. Again, this is due by **31 March 08** for dates between July 08 thru Jun 09.
