February Roundtable will be held on the 13th of February at the ACS building on Humphreys.

First Aid Merit Badge Training: The District will be having a First Aid Merit Badge day at the Osan Hospital, 0830 – 1700, 9 Feb 2008. Time permitting there might be a First Aid competition. All Troops invited. Cost is \$5 for the meet (includes one patch) and \$5 for any additional event patches.

Presidents Day Bowl-a-thon: The District has selected February 18th as the “District Bowl-a-thon” day. Each participating unit may choose any date between 01 Feb and 30 Mar. Keep in mind that the money must be turned into District by 31 Mar for maximum commission. The expected payouts are 25% if turned in by 31 Mar or 15% if turned in by 15 Apr. An extra 10% may be earned if your unit averages \$100 per boy or >\$1,000 in pledges. Packages are available at the district office or at the Roundtable meetings. Ensure your Troop selects YOUR date and get BOWLING!!

Day Camp: District Day Camp 19 April 2008. This is a GREAT opportunity to give a boy some interaction with Cubs and a little leadership time. There is a MANDATORY training for all Den Leaders (guides) at the Scout Hut on 03 April 08 @ 1300 (1 p.m.).
